If you are over 18 and live or work in the Parish of St Agnes, which includes Porthtowan, Mount Hawke, Blackwater and Mithian, you could be eligible to become a Parish Councillor. The Council are looking for one person to represent the Mithian ward, though applicants can be from other parts of the Parish.

Full Council meetings are on the evening of the first Mondays of the month, and additional committee meetings occur at various times. You should be able to commit to attend most of the Full Council meetings, and have an interest in the local community. You do not need any prior experience of local government or politics.
