



Dear Resident or business owner,

Saints Trails - Multi Use Paths The Designated Funds programme - Cycling Safety & Integration

We are writing to let you know that we are hosting some public events for local residents and businesses who are interested in finding more about the Designated Funds programme and the work that will be carried out.

As part of the Road Investment Strategy, Highways England were given funding to improve the surroundings of the Strategic Road Network in a way that supports and protects people and the things we value whilst enhancing quality of life. Known as the Designated Funds Programme, part of these funds has been allocated to the Cycling Safety and Integration project and is being used to support projects close to the A30, improving the safety and integration of communities through a number of high-quality off-road trails.

Four continuous paths, designed for shared use leisure and cycling, will utilise forestry tracks, old railway track beds, bridges, field margins, and disused paths and will connect to existing routes. They will run from St Agnes to Threemilestone (via Chiverton Cross), Perranporth to Newquay, St Newlyn East to Carland Cross, and Trispen to Idless. A fifth scheme will run along the detrunked A30 after the dualling of the A30 is complete.

The exhibitions are in advance of the projects, following which planning permission and other statutory approvals will be sought later this year. The works could potentially start in early spring 2020. Please come along and see us between 1200hrs and 2000hrs on the dates and venues listed below. Members of the project team will be there to explain the routes in more detail and answer any questions you may have.
