
Results of the St Agnes Parish Council Housing Needs Survey

4,096 households were surveyed between 10th January 2022 to 28 February 2022. 613 responses. Response rate 15%. n. = the number of responses

Does a member of your household need Affordable Housing?

218 households stated they were in need of affordable housing, of which 205 households stated they had a local connection to the Parish of St Agnes.

Current housing circumstances households in housing need



198 (91%) of households in need of affordable housing live in the parish.

Preferred Locations: of the 218 households in need of affordable housing

105 want to live anywhere in the parish (48%) **26** want to live in Wheal Rose, Mt Hawke or Porthtowan (12%)

84 want to live in St Agnes (38%)

3 want to live outside the parish (2%)

Self-Build:

104

households responding to the survey that they would be interested in self-build (47%).



Hidden Households:

142

households responded to the survey to say they were in need of affordable housing and not registered with Help to Buy South or Homechoice.



Of these **128** stated they had a current local connection to the Parish of St Agnes.



Affordable Home Ownership: Shared Ownership and Discount

Market Sale. Shared Ownership is a type of affordable home ownership where a purchaser takes out a mortgage on a share of a property and pays rent to a Registered Provider landlord on the remaining share. Discount Market Sale is where the home is purchased at a discounted rate from the open market value. The discount remains on the property in perpetuity.
